### B) Manager Profile

- Andy Crosby, 52, English
- Preferred 4-2-3-1, organised and high energy, emphasis on pressing and width
- Appointed May 2025, first permanent role after assistant stints, improved Rovers' form
- Record to date strong, about 1.46 points per match, first meeting vs Gills as manager

### C) Form & League Position

- League: 4th, 4 points, GD +4 (after 2 matches)
- Last 5, all comps: W 4–0 Shrewsbury (H), D 1–1 Colchester (A), W 1–0 Marine (FR), W 4–1 Newport (A, end of 24/25), W 2–0 Crewe (H)
- Unbeaten run across competitive matches, have not conceded from open play in the league

#### **D) Tactical Style & Weaknesses**

- Formation: 4-2-3-1 with two holding mids (Smallwood, Kenneh)
- Strengths: wing play and overlaps, aggressive press, aerial power on set pieces
- Weaknesses: late lapses in concentration, young attackers can be streaky, limited central creativity if flanks are stifled, discipline watch (Kenneh booked already)

#### **E) Key Players & Milestones**

- **Omari Patrick** – direct winger, last season 11 league goals, already scored this season
- **Richard Smallwood** – captain and shield, 400+ career games, sets the tone
- **Kristian Dennis** – veteran finisher off the bench, scored in the 4–0 win, closing on 100 league goals
- **Nohan Kenneh** – 22-year-old Liberia international, breaks up play, athletic presence

#### **F) Opposition Threat Summary**

- Chances via quick transitions and wide overloads, crosses into Davison and late runners
- Set plays are a major weapon, target Smith and Turnbull, watch Smallwood's deliveries
- Press to trap opponents in their own third, mistakes lead to cutbacks for Patrick or Harris

- **Jonathan Williams** – experienced playmaker, links lines, keeps the ball moving
